### Resolution No. 751

**In the name of the people**

**The Revolutionary Command Council**

Based on the provisions of Paragraph (a) of Article (42) of the Constitution, The Revolutionary Command Council decided in its meeting held on 3/ 7/ 1985 issuing the following law.

**No. (56) of 1985**

**Maritime Agency Law**

#### Article 1

The General Establishment of Iraqi Maritime Agencies shall exclusively carry out the work of maritime agencies in Iraqi ports in accordance with the provisions of (Branch Two) of (Chapter Four) of Transport Law No. (80) of 1983 and the services arising therefrom shall be provided.

#### Article 2

The Establishment shall charge the internationally recognized wages, in accordance with a special table issued by it.

### Article 3

The Establishment may not accept wages lower than the wages indicated in the table, except with the approval of the Board of Directors of the Iraqi Public Establishment for Water Transport and the approval of the Minister Transportation and Communications.

### Article 4

The Establishment may carry out the works of supplying ships with navigators, fuel, materials, provisions and any other works within its competence.

### Article 5

The Minister may issue instructions to facilitate Implementation of this law.

### Article 6

The Maritime Agency Law No. (46) of 1969 shall be repealed.

### Article 7

This law shall come into force from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

### Amendment

### Resolution No. 84

Based on the approval of Parliament, in accordance with the provisions of Item (First) of Article (61) and Item (Third) of Article (73) of the Constitution, the President of Republic decided on 22/ 10/ 2012 issuing the following law:

No. (83) of 2012

**Law of First Amendment of Maritime  
Agency Law**

No. (56) of 1985

### Article 1

The text of Article (1) of the Maritime Agency Law No. (56) of 1985 shall be repealed and replaced with the following:

### Article 1

The General Company for Maritime Transport, or whoever it authorizes from among the companies established in accordance with the provisions of the Company Law No. (21) of 1997, shall carry out the work of marine agencies in Iraqi ports, in accordance with the provisions of (Branch Second) of (Chapter Four) of the Transport Law No. (80) of 1983 and shall provide the services arising therefrom.

### Article 2

The text of Article (4) of the law shall be repealed and replaced with the following:

### Article 4

First: The General Maritime Transport Company shall supply ships, oil tankers and commercial floating marine units that enter the Iraqi waters and the ports with navigators, fuel, materials and provisions, fresh water and any other requirements that serve the Maritime transportation work within its jurisdiction.

Second: The company may authorize and license marine services companies established in accordance with the provisions of the Companies Law No. (21) of 1997 to provide the services stipulated in Item (First) of this Article.

### Article 3

The order of the Temporary Coalition authority (dissolved) No. (51) of 2004 shall be repealed.

### Article 4

This law shall be effective from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
