RESOLUTION NO. (64)

Based on what had been approved by the Parliament, in accordance with the provisions of Item (First) of Article (61) and Item (Third) of Article (73) of the Constitution, the President of Republic decided in October 1, 2012 issuing the following law:

LAW NO. (63) OF 2012

**IRAQI GOVERNMENTAL UNIVERSITY AND
INSTITUTE STUDENT GRANT LAW**

ARTICLE 1

A monthly financial grant shall be paid to Iraqi limited-income-family students with in undergraduate and postgraduate studies in government universities and institutes in accordance with the following:

First: (100,000) One hundred thousand dinars for students of undergraduate studies (bachelor) and students of technical colleges (bachelor) and technical institutes (technical diploma) affiliated to the Technical Education Authority.

Second: (150,000) One hundred and fifty thousand dinars for postgraduate students of doctorate, masters and higher diploma.

ARTICLE 2

First: The amount of the grant stipulated in Item (First) of Article (1) of this law shall be paid to students of undergraduate studies, students of technical colleges (bachelor) and students of the technical diploma for a period of (9) nine months, starting from October 1 of each academic year until June 30 thereof, and not exceeding the minimum period of study.

Second: The amount of the grant stipulated in Item (Second) of Article (1) of this law shall be paid to postgraduate students starting from the date of the start of the study until the end of the minimum period of study.

ARTICLE 3

The grant amount shall be ceased in one of the following cases:

First: Postponing the study

Second: Failure.

Third: The student's absence rate reaches more than (10%) ten percent annually in one or more academic curriculum during the academic year or semester.

Fourth: Dismissal from study.

ARTICLE 4

The grant shall not be disbursed to each of the following:

First: The employee.

Second: The student who is granted an allowance pursuant to the law, and he/ she shall not be granted the difference between the grant and the allowance if the latter is less than the amount of the grant.

ARTICLE 5

First: The grant amount shall be disbursed to the student covered by the provisions of this law in person, and acting on his/ her behalf by proxy shall not be accepted:

Second: The grant amount shall be paid exclusively to morning-study students at public universities.

ARTICLE 6

The Council of Ministers may include students of specialized institutes affiliated with other ministries under the provisions of this law based on a proposal by the competent minister.

ARTICLE 7

The Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research, in coordination with the Minister of Finance, shall issue instructions to facilitate the implementation of the provisions of this law.

ARTICLE 8

This law shall be effective once it is published in the Official Gazette.

**INSTRUCTIONS OF FACILITATING THE
IMPLEMENTATION OF IRAQI
GOVERNMENTAL UNIVERSITY AND
INSTITUTE STUDENT GRANT LAW**

NO.(63) OF 2012

ARTICLE 1

The monthly financial grant stipulated in the Iraqi Governmental University and Institute Student Grant Law No.(63) of 2012 shall be disbursed in accordance with the following:

First: Submitting an application by the student in accordance with a form prepared for this purpose.

Second: A letter stating the amount of household head's income issued by the department where the student's household head works, if he/she is an employee or issued by the Local Council in case the household head is not an employee.

Third: A title deed or rental contract for the student's family house for the purpose of determining the family's net income.

Fourth: A copy of the student's ID.

ARTICLE 2

Limited-income-family student means the one whose income does not exceed (150,000) one hundred and fifty thousand Dinars per month out of the family income.

ARTICLE 3

First: The financial authority in the college or institute shall check the applications of students who want to obtain the grant and submit them to the university.

Second: The financial affair section in a university shall be responsible for verifying the authentication of documents and completing requirements before submitting them to the Ministry at the beginning of each academic year.

Third: The Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research shall provide the Ministry of Finance with the number of students included by the grant when preparing the Ministry's draft annual budget.

ARTICLE 4

These instructions shall be implemented as of the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
